

What is Argentina's energy transition?

With its increasing focus on wind and solar energy, Argentina's dependence on gas has steadily decreased since 2019. Argentina aims for 47% renewable electricity by 2030, while the IEA's Net Zero Emissions scenario sets out a global target of 60% renewable electricity by 2030. What is Energa Argentina SA?

Energa Argentina SA is the state-owned energy agency responsible for the production, transport, and trade of petroleum, natural gas, and electricity. MAyDS (Ministerio de Ambiente y Desarrollo Sostenible) is the Argentine environmental authority responsible for granting licenses for new power generation projects.

How renewable energy penetration can be achieved in Argentina?

Renewable energy penetration. In order to reach the 20 % target for 2025, installed renewable generation capacity must increase to 10,000 MW from a current base of only 800 MW in operation in the country. Power demand in Argentina has historically grown by 2-3% p.a. and it is high

Are Argentine oil and gas companies moving towards the power industry?

The Argentine market is not stranger to the shift of oil and gas companies towards the power industry. Different long-standing Argentine oil and gas companies like Tecpetrol, Pan American Energy (PAE) and YPF have been investing in renewable generation projects in the past years.

The new company, Pan American Energy Group (PAEG), will be the largest privately-owned integrated energy company operating in Argentina. PAEG will be owned equally by BP and Bridas Corporation, itself a 50:50 joint venture of Bridas Energy Holdings of Argentina and CNOOC Limited of China. PAE is currently owned 60% by BP and 40% by Bridas ...

Analyzing the energy sector, Markous declared Vaca Muerta to be a "game-changer" for Argentina, providing 150 years of gas and 75 years of oil reserves. "In 2024, over 55% of the barrels produced in Argentina are



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coming from unconventional sources. By 2030, we anticipate producing 1.5 million barrels per day, thanks to Vaca Muerta."
