A fully upgrade Energy Cell holds 150 million RF (~12,500 RF/t to empty in one night). If that isn't enough for you, then you are probably already using Draconic Evolution or another mod capable of handling it's own ridiculous power requirements.

In 1.12 my go-to was Draconic Evolution's energy core, since a couple of trillion RF was ample space for most of my playthroughs. But DE isn't a thing in 1.16, so I need an ...

My single player works fine, but on my server I get "Unable to activate (Invalid Configuration)". I have double checked everything they are setup exactly the same.

The Energy Core is a machine added by Draconic Evolution energy storage system. It is the central part of the Energy Core multiblock which can store massive amounts of Redstone Flux (RF). This structure comes in 8 tiers.

Draconic Evolution provides a unique twist on storing energy. The Draconic Energy Core consists of a central "orb" and a number of Energy Core Stabilizers positioned around the core. Energy Pylons are used to transfer power in and out of the Energy Core. There are eight tiers, each providing a greater amount of storage, and each requiring a greater amount of materials to ...

What I am currently doing is squirt a small amount of the power (about 3000 RF/t through a Thermal Expansion Energy Cell (used as a regulator)). This 3000 RF goes into my already full Draconic power storage (I think its only tier 3), then what remains (roughly 21kRF/t) goes to my laser drill and 2 ender quarry set ups.

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worked fine and it's charging like it's supposed to. To the problem. I left it to charge a bit while doing other stuff in my base. When I later came back to check the energy it ...

Probably The Best Solution Is The Tier 8 draconic energy core, but is expensive, you can also make the induction matrix multiblock from mekanism, its easy and with an automation (from ae2) you can autocraft the cells really fast

Currently the Energy Core will only check for 6 specific Draconium blocks to see if the multiblock is valid but returns the full structure on deconstruction.

Ender IO capacitors can become a multiblock energy storage. Draconic Evolution has a multiblock energy storage as well but that one requires a bit more specific construction.

If you leave the core in the same spot and only add/remove blocks around it, it will maintain its energy level. If you break the core with a pick it will lose its power. However, you can use a Thaumcraft wand focus of dislocation to move the core block without losing any power that it may contain, and then the building around it rule still ...

My brother and I had issues creating one for the first time as well, try moving the Particle Generators a bit closer. I don't remember if a 1x1 will work for the multiblock (Not in-game at the moment to read the documentation), but try adding redstone blocks and draconic blocks onto it, maybe that might help

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
