The two 30 MW projects will be the first developed in Senegal under the Scaling Solar program overseen by the World Bank, which operates the IFC as its private sector investment arm.

Is Senegal bidding to add 200 MW of new generation capacity?

Senegal is bidding to have added 200 MW of new generation capacity in the period from 2016 up to next year. A trio of international development lenders will provide EUR38 million in loans to fund two 30 MW solar power plants in Senegal.
