The Human Rights Measurement Initiative (HRMI) finds that Sao Tome and Principe is fulfilling only 83.8% of its expected commitments to the right to education based on the country's level of income. HRMI breaks down the right to education by looking at the rights to both primary education and secondary education.

And so on to Principe. In order to get to Principe there is one flight a day 5 out of 7 days, with STP Airways (c1hr duration) done in a turbo prop from the last century. In order to board the flight you need to have an antigen test done in Sao Tome. This is relatively straight forward, just don't leave it till the last minute.

Note: A Yellow Fever Certificate is required for all travellers visiting Sao Tome & Principe, and officers check all visitors upon arrival. Currency: The local currency used in Sao Tome & Principe is the Sao Tomean Dobra (STN). At the time of writing: USD \$1 = 21.20 STN / EUR 1 = 24.58 ST
